Who is eligible?

- Applicants must be a graduate of the current year
- Applicants must be planning to enroll in a college or trade school of their choice

Judging criteria:

- Applicants will be judged on leadership, volunteer service, school and community involvement using a point system, and the content of their **250 word essay**
- Applicants who are a member of Hometown Credit Union will receive preferential consideration

Application Deadline:

Applications are <u>due by April 4, 2025</u> and can be dropped off at your local Hometown Credit Union with the Branch Manager.

The scholarship winners will be notified by the beginning of May and will be presented the award at Graduation or your school's Award Night. The scholarship funds will be paid at the beginning of the 2nd semester jointly to the recipient and the school applicant is enrolled in.
